Changing the Face of Business




The Importance of Spend

Employees only think about the finance and IT departments when there's a monthly reminder to file expense claims or if there's an interruption in service. But make no mistake: the finance and IT departments are always thinking about them.

By some estimates, employee spend accounts for as much as 65% of an organisation's controllable spend,¹ spread across many employees who are traveling, buying business meals, and purchasing products and services on behalf of the business.

Employee spend is a tricky area to manage because travel and expense is not uniform. Staff members with varying degrees of policy mastery make requests, travel, spend, and submit expenses, while sometimes inadvertently spending outside of their organisation's policies in remarkably unique ways. Smartphones and greater choices in travel, from Airbnb to ride services, have created even more variations in expenses.


Expense, travel, and AP accounts for **up to 65%** of the typical organisation's spend.



In response, policy infractions prompt companies to refine the rules but, like sand, the harder you squeeze to hold on, the more escapes between your fingers.

New taxes, shifting regulations, and privacy concerns also pose continual challenges. For a domestic organisation, it's a full-time job just to keep up with changes in one country; each additional international location an organisation does business in multiplies the task.





SAP Concur checks transactions, across many languages, against an organisation's specific policies and a knowledge base of millions of other transactions and third-party data sources. If an employee fraudulently or accidentally tries to submit an out-of-policy expense, the system flags the error and coaches the employee to set things right. As employees learn the SAP Concur platform, the anonymised data they provide helps the app learn in return.

With rule-based budgeting and analytics solutions, technology can help the finance team take care of the details, offering the control and visibility to zoom from the big picture down to the transaction level and see what's happening as it occurs.



AGILITY: RESPOND FASTER TO CHANGE

The two capabilities of **visibility** and **focus** enable a third: **agility**. With near real-time budgeting and analytics tools, Intelligent Enterprises allow business leaders to respond quickly to events as they unfold. For instance, if a business unit leader can see how much of their budget is spent and what's planned at a granular level, they have the ability to make more nuanced decisions. Instead of simply freezing spending and travel, they may instead prioritise that which provides the best return for their organisation.

But agility doesn't just apply to management functions, it impacts everyone in the company on a personal level. Travel is the great equalizer because, regardless of title, everyone needs efficiency, safety, and assistance when they are on the road for business and everyone is a travel and expense "user." When employees travel, aggregated data and connections with travel suppliers like airlines and hotel chains allow users scheduling agility and the flexibility to work with their favorite brands. Business travellers are proactively notified about gate changes quickly – often before airline gate agents know. With location services, SAP Concur sends timely reminders, based on local traffic and security line wait times, suggesting when users should leave for the airport.

The most important part of these capabilities is the outcomes. When companies provide great, easy-to-use tools for their business travellers, they save employees valuable time, increase adoption, compliance, and give them the confidence that they are doing things right.

On the back-end, when teams are freed from time-consuming, repetitive tasks, they have more time, energy, and information to focus on new opportunities and high-value projects. For instance, by consolidating direct booking into a centralised travel system, travel managers have a more complete picture of travel spend and the ability to negotiate the best rates, even when employees don't use internal booking tools. This gives finance and travel managers the superpower to see "invisible spend," gaining not just a complete picture of travel and expense ROI, but full itineraries for duty of care.

The combined capabilities of the Intelligent Enterprise also support businesses as they expand globally. SAP cloud solutions provide growing organisations with the insights and experience they need to refine their processes as they enter new markets with different business environments. It's much easier to plug into systems that already ensure compliance with regulations than to build those systems and processes internally from scratch.

As workforces become more dispersed, the challenge of making sure employees are safe is increasing. Employees expect assistance and personalisation in travel; this is an opportunity for finance, travel, and IT departments at an Intelligent Enterprise to work strategically across the organisation on issues personally relevant to employees.

For example, predictive analytics and employee spend data play a crucial role in keeping employees safe. 


